

Workshop Application/Submission Guidelines

- Advanced Workshop tuition: \$625
- Intermediate Workshop tuition: \$425

Applications must be postmarked or e-mailed by October 31, 2006

You will be notified in November.

To apply by mail: send two copies of the completed application form below with three of your best poems, a stamped self-addressed envelope and a \$20 non-refundable reading fee to: Workshop Admissions, c/o Bliumis-Dunn, 23 Round Hill Road, Armonk, NY 10504.

To apply online: fill out our [online application form](#) and attach with three poems and credit card information for \$20 non-refundable reading fee and tuition fees.

Your three-poem manuscript must: (1) be no longer than six pages, (2) be in standard, twelve-point type, and (3) contain no name or contact information anywhere on poems. Send your best work, not poems you intend to discuss in workshop.

Workshop preferences: Be flexible. We'll try to honor requests, but cannot guarantee it. After choosing qualified manuscripts, blind lotteries will be used to fill the seats, adjusting for workshop preferences. The earlier you apply, the better your chances of getting into your preferred workshop. Standards for admission to intermediate workshops are less stringent than for advanced workshops.

Lodging and Transportation: January is the height of the vacation season in Delray Beach. We suggest you reserve a hotel room and car soon. Don't wait to receive notification.

Final payment is due five days after notification of acceptance. To expedite payment, please attach checks for reading fee and tuition or supply credit card information for payment of both. **We will not charge the card nor deposit the tuition check until you have been notified of your acceptance.** All sales are final, although we will issue a 50% refund if cancellation occurs before January 9 and we are able to fill your seat with a wait-listed applicant.
